The **SOCCERBUS** service operates to all Liverpool home matches, Premier League, domestic Cup and European games.

The service runs from Sandhills Merseyrail station, linking with Northern Line trains from Liverpool city centre (Liverpool Central or Moorfields), Southport, Hunts Cross, Ormskirk and Kirkby.

SOCCERBUS runs for two hours before each match and 50 minutes after the whistle (subject to availability).

When buying your train ticket, simply ask for 'Anfield' - for just £1 extra, you'll get a return ticket for the **SOCCERBUS** service. Or, you can buy a ticket when you board the bus - a single/return ticket is just £1.50.

SOCCERBUS is **free** to those with valid Trio, Solo and Saveaway tickets or Concessionary Passes.

The **SOCCERBUS** service has been provided by Merseytravel, with support from Liverpool and Everton Football Clubs.

If you're travelling to Anfield on a non-matchday (to visit the grounds and take in a stadium tour, to visit the Club Shop, or just to pick up your tickets for a future match), this leaflet shows you which buses will get you there.

The map on the inside of the leaflet highlights the ground, lists the bus services that will get you there and shows the locations of the bus stops in the city centre and around the ground.

The list of bus services also shows you their general frequencies through the week, but if you're aiming to get there for a particular time, you can:

- download the specific timetable leaflet from the Merseytravel website at www.merseytravel.gov.uk
- pick up a timetable from a Merseytravel Centre
- call Traveline on 0871 200 22 33 and they'll be able to give you all the information you need

Depending on the day and time that the match is kicking off, most of the buses listed will also get you there on matchdays. However, for all Premier League and domestic and European matches, there's the **SOCCERBUS** service (details included in this leaflet), and there's also Route 917 which operates from St John's Lane, down the side of St George's Hall.
